Vanessa German, Black Girl with Snakes

- Vanessa German (American, born 1976) is a Pittsburgh-based self-taught citizen artist and the fourth living artist to be featured in Spotlight.
- Made in 2020, the artist references themes of rebirth, rejuvenation, and hope in times of uncertainty and loss during the global pandemic.
- German sources a wide range of found objects and decorative elements to create her power figures, relying on the "frequency of yes" to guide selection and placement.
- BLACK GIRL WITH SNAKES includes porcelain figurines, fake plants, sequined snakes, mirrors, and birds all surrounding a central Black female power figure.
- In addition to sculpture, German expresses herself through photography and spoken word.
